



## *The First Ten Plays*

### GO KITS\*

- **Family contact list and copy of your I.D. (Driver's license, SS Card)**
- **Communications device with backup batteries  
(Add a photovoltaic charger if you can afford it.)**
- **Quarters and a call card for use at pay phones**
- **Maps of your area—including sites of nearest pay phones**
- **Water--what you can manage and maintain---recycle every six months  
(Consider a portable water filtering and treatment kit.)**
- **Basic dry camping food supplies  
(Consider energy bars, dried fruit, dried meats, etc.—think light weight.)**
- **Basic first aid kit with instructions**
- **Compass (only if you know how to use one)**
- **Metal police-style whistle (valuable if trapped or lost---saves voice)**
- **Flashlight/radio that can be hand cranked, has photovoltaic, and rechargeable batteries  
(Have the Emergency Alert Station numbers painted on the outside.)**

*\* These are not listed in order of importance but as a group of materials that will increase the possibility of positive outcomes.*
